## GUIDELINES

### General Rules:

- Entries on valid College ID or with valid photo ID.
- Participant shall carry the registration receipt on the competition day.
- Maximum number of team members is two.
- Any kind of obscenity, vulgarity, misbehavior will lead to immediate disqualification.
- Judge's decision is final and binding for every team.
- The organizers reserve the rights to change/update the rules of the contest at any point of time and will do their best to inform the participants of the same. However, it is ultimately the responsibility of the teams to keep themselves updated.
- All sharp objects, inflammable objects will not be allowed. Only technical personnel will handle all equipments.
- Take care of your personal bringing, as college will not be responsible for any loss.
- A team/individual can participate in all five activities (Paper/Poster/Project/Singing/Dance) subject to condition that, he/she/they should register separately.

### Rules of Paper Presentation:

- Each team/individual can select any one of the given topics.
- Paper is to be submitted in IEEE format available on college website- www.vmvjmt.com.
- The paper should not contain more than 4 typed pages.
- The paper will be accepted only in \*.doc, \*.docx & \*.pdf formats.
- Teams should mention their full details in the paper. (Name of the Authors, Departments, Phone numbers, College, etc.).
- E-mail the soft copy of the full paper to paperprayas@vmvjmt.com before due date.
- The teams will get ten minutes to present their idea. This will be followed by a question and answer session by judges and/or students attending the presentation for 3 minutes duration. Marks will be deducted for every minute exceeded after ten minutes. All the members of the team should be present during the presentation.
- The final presentation should be made in Microsoft Power Point only.
- Paper will carry 20 Marks and will be evaluated based on the following criteria :

### Rules of Poster Presentation:

- Posters must not be greater than 3 feet in width and 2.5 feet in height (maximum) or will be disqualified.
- Use bullet lists, charts, figures, tables, equations, and photographs as applicable to highlight the important technical content of your work.
- Printed and handwritten posters are allowed for contest but, a printed poster with graphics produced using page layout software will greatly increase the effectiveness of your presentation.
- Symbols, letters, and numbers should be large enough to be seen from a distance of six feet. Lines in illustrations should be heavy.

- Each presentation should contain a top panel listing the title of the abstract and the names, Departments, Phone numbers, College, etc of the authors.
- Pushpins, tape, and poster numbers will be available at the session.
- Your presentation material must be available for viewing and you must be available for discussion during the entire Student Paper Competition Poster Session.
- Poster Presentation will carry 30 Marks and will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

### **Rules of Project Competition:**

- Projects must be the original design and creation of the students.
- Subject matter is the choice of the participants.
- All required basic infrastructural facilities like working space, electricity, computer, tables, mounting boards, LCD projector, overhead projector etc., will be made available by the host institution. For any special requirements, if any, participants should inform the coordinator well in advance.
- In the first round, projects can be in the form of live demonstration/models/software/hardware and should be based on innovative ideas on given themes.
- Selected projects from the Round-I will have to give oral presentation before judges.
- Each oral presentation will be given eight minutes for presentation and two minutes for question and answers.
- Project Competition will carry 30 Marks and will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

### **Rules of Singing Competition:**

- Participant must bring karaoke or instrumental music with self to perform.
- Time allotted for each performance (Solo & Duet) is maximum 7 minutes.
- Participant should sing full song. Participants will not be allowed to refer to the lyrics while singing.
- Choice of song is open to the participants but the song should not have any slangs or derogatory language.
- Song should be sung in Hindi / Marathi language (No other languages are allowed).
- Contestants are not permitted to leave the stage or stage area during their performance. This includes singing or performing within the audience.
- Only one entry per Institute / College is allowed for solo and duet singing both.
- Only twenty registrations will be done (10 - Solo and 10 - Duet) on first come first serve basis. Registration will be completed after payment the registration fees.
- Singing Competition will carry 30 Marks and will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

### **Rules of Dance Competition:**

- The Participant needs to carry an audio CD/DVD/Pen Drives with the track number written on it.
- We support MP3 and MP4 files. The maximum file duration is 5 Minutes for Solo Dance and 6 Minutes for Duet Dance.
- Any person who is visible on stage once the routine has started will be considered a performer.
- Fire, swords, guns, knives or live animals are strictly prohibited.
- No form of liquids which may affect the stage surface may be used during a routine.
- Smoking is prohibited in the competition.
- No alcoholic beverages.
- Contestant should be ready 1 hour before their scheduled time.
- You can carry your props if you required.
- Only one entry per Institute / College is allowed for solo and duet dances both.
- Only twenty registrations will be done (10 - Solo and 10 - Duet) on first come first serve basis. Registration will be completed after payment the registration fees.
- Dance Competition will carry 30 Marks and will be evaluated based on the following criteria:
